

### Creative Process Teacher Checklist

This tool can be used across multiple classes, depending on when students work through each stage. It is not necessary to assess every stage.

<b>Creative Process Stages</b>	<b>Success Criteria</b>	<b>✓ or X</b>	<b>Feedback for Students</b>
<b>Challenging and Inspiring</b>	Identifies a compelling idea that sparks creativity and engagement		
<b>Imagining and Generating</b>	Generates a range of creative and relevant ideas based on the stimulus, topic or theme		
<b>Planning and Focusing</b>	Creates a focused and realistic plan with clear goals that meet the criteria		
<b>Exploring and Experimenting</b>	Explores different elements, techniques, strategies, devices or forms, and takes risks with confidence		
<b>Producing Preliminary Work</b>	Produces well-developed drafts that reflect thoughtful preparation		
<b>Revising and Refining</b>	Thoughtfully revises work using feedback to improve quality		
<b>Presenting, Performing, and Sharing</b>	Presents work clearly and confidently to an audience that is well-rehearsed		
<b>Reflecting and Evaluating</b>	Thoughtfully evaluates both process and product, identifying strengths and areas for growth.
